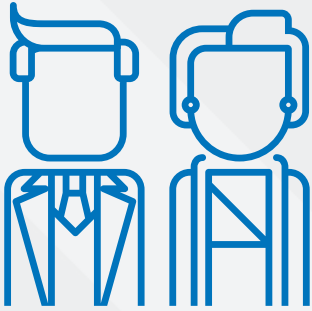




THE BEATTIE FOUNDATION PRESENTS

We think this is an idea whose time has come. We live in a land where money lenders make money off the same vulnerable people our Foundation is trying to support. Big money. They are utter bankers. And we're going to do something about them.

Our Bank Of Mum And Dad will offer interest and charge-free loans (that's right. INTEREST-FREE loans) to individuals facing challenges to their Dignity, Freedom and Sanctuary. As its title suggests, our scheme will be guided by the abiding principles of Jack And Ada: we will only support those furthering our Foundation Values of Freedom, Dignity and Sanctuary. Repaid funds will in turn become loans for others.

- Credit is repayable by no more than 12 instalments (eg. Monthly) within no more than 12 months (schedule to be set by the Bank of Mum and Dad).
- Loans must be sought and used to purchase goods or services. (Borrower-Lender-Supplier agreement).
- Loans will always be awarded as a fixed amount.
- Loans awarded will involve no charges or interest.
- Applicants will be required to provide bank statements for the last 3 months to prove insufficient funds available to meet their need.
- Applicants will be required to provide two referees who are in a professional capacity, able to confirm the circumstance the loan applicant finds themselves in.
